



PFPO Routine Veterinary Care

For puppies (less than 6 months old)

- Vaccines & Fecal/Dewormer
 - Start the vaccine series at 6-8 weeks of age
 - Repeat the vaccine series every 3-4 weeks until the puppy is 16 weeks old
 - In total, puppies should receive 2-3 DHPP vaccines & 1 bordetella vaccine
 - Puppies should have 2 fecals performed & will be given dewormer as necessary
 - At 16 weeks, the puppy should receive 1 rabies vaccine, and the last set of DHPP vaccines
- Spay/Neuter
 - Puppies can be spayed or neutered as early as 8 weeks
- Microchip
 - Puppies should receive a microchip when they are spayed or neutered
- Monthly Care
 - Heartworm prevention
 - Flea & tick prevention

For adults (greater than 6 months old)

- At the time of possession, your adult dog must have:
 - Heartworm test
 - Fecal
 - Dewormer as necessary
 - Spay/Neuter
 - Microchip
 - DHPP
 - Bordetella
 - Rabies
- Then, 3-4 weeks later, your adult dog will need a DHPP booster
 - In total, adult dogs should receive 2 DHPP vaccines
- Monthly Care
 - Heartworm prevention
 - Dr. Kris must see your foster dog & have a negative heartworm test prior to dispensing heartworm prevention
 - Flea & tick prevention

PFPO Non-Routine Veterinary Care

Common ailments (i.e. UTI, ear infection, dermatitis, kennel cough)

- With your POC approval, schedule an appointment at:
 - Columbus Dog Connection
 - SOS of Ohio
 - With Dr. Haumschild at Animal Hospital of Shawnee Hills
 - Health & Harmony Animal Hospital
- Call Dr. Haumschild if you are concerned it is an emergency

Uncommon ailments (i.e. parvo, fracture, amputation)

- Call Dr. Haumschild FIRST
- Dr. Haumschild will direct you to the next course of action
 - If the dog has a life threatening illness (i.e. parvo), it will be managed at either Animal Hospital of Shawnee Hills or Health & Harmony Animal Hospital
 - If the dog has an orthopedic condition (i.e. fracture or amputation), it will initially be managed at either Animal Hospital of Shawnee Hills or Health & Harmony Animal Hospital
 - If necessary, a consult will be made to another facility
 - If the dog has an uncommon illness (i.e. Lewis or Drama), the dog will first be evaluated by Dr. Haumschild, Animal Hospital of Shawnee Hills, or Health & Harmony Animal Hospital
 - If necessary, the dog will be referred for a specialty consult

Dentals

- Dental disease will be evaluated by Dr. Haumschild & referred to the appropriate facility

Costs related to non - routine veterinary care

- Any procedure, test, treatment, or additional diagnostics exceeding the cost of \$600 will have to be approved by the Board of Directors
- Dr. Haumschild will notify Katie Scholl of the medical recommendations & Katie will then send an email to the Board for majority to sign-off
