



### Adoption Event Etiquette/Guidelines

- ALL dogs **MUST** be spayed/neutered prior to attending an event.
- Dogs **MUST** be current on vaccines including rabies.
- If you have recently obtained your foster dog, please do not bring to any adoption events for at least 2 weeks.
- There should be 1 person per 1 foster dog.
- Adoption events can be stressful. If you are at an event and realize your foster dog is not handling the stress well (i.e. growling, barking, biting, etc) please **LEAVE** the event. It is **NEVER** wrong to error on the side of caution.
- If there is an incident with a foster dog at an event (i.e. a dog bite) you **MUST** notify your foster coordinator or a director **IMMEDIATELY**.
- Please be courteous of the organizations that allow PFPO to host adoption events. If your foster dog has an accident please be sure to clean it up.
- During the winter months events are inside, and thereby we are limited to a number of dogs that attend. Generally, we can only have 3-5 dogs at these events. If your foster dog does not handle stress well, please do not take up a space for another dog that may be able to attend.
