

Adoption Event Etiquette/Guidelines

- ALL dogs MUST be spayed/neutered prior to attending an event.
- Dogs MUST be current on vaccines including rabies.
- If you have recently obtained your foster dog, please do not bring to any adoption events for at least 2 weeks.
- There should be 1 person per 1 foster dog.
- Adoption events can be stressful. If you are at an event and realize your foster dog is not handling the stress well (i.e. growling, barking, biting, etc) please LEAVE the event. It is NEVER wrong to error on the side of caution.
- If there is an incident with a foster dog at an event (i.e. a dog bite) you MUST notify your foster coordinator or a director IMMEDIATELY.
- Please be courteous of the organizations that allow PFPO to host adoption events. If your foster dog has an accident please be sure to clean it up.
- During the winter months events are inside, and thereby we are limited to a number of dogs that attend. Generally, we can only have 3-5 dogs at these events. If your foster dog does not handle stress well, please do not take up a space for another dog that may be able to attend.
